- Use a blank area of the map to draw an inset that shows a more detailed version of part of the map (you may choose what area of the world to draw). Label at least two features in your inset.

**7. Color the entire map using blue for water and a unique color for each continent (4 points)**

**8. Quality of work (5 points)**

- Lightly color the map in color pencil, not markers. Color in one direction and stay within the lines.
- All labels must be written neatly in pen so they are easy to read.
- Capitalize the first letter of proper nouns. Spell words correctly.
